(a semiconductor manufacturing company) and was responsible for global strategy, marketing and engineering for the company's embedded communications and applications processor business. Dr. Su joined Freescale in 2007 as chief technology officer, where she led the company's technology roadmap and research and development efforts.

Dr. Su spent the previous 13 years at IBM in various engineering and business leadership positions, including vice president of the Semiconductor Research and Development Center responsible for the strategic direction of IBM's silicon technologies, joint development alliances and semiconductor R&D operations. **M. Susan Hardwick is President and Chief Executive Officer of American Water Works Company, Inc.**

Ms. Hardwick joined American Water in June 2019 and became CFO in July of that same year. In this role, she was responsible for all aspects of financial management and strategy, including treasury, financial planning, accounting, investor relations, internal audit, risk management, supply chain, regulatory services, and control functions. In February 2022, she was named President and CEO, and was elected to serve on the Board of Directors at American Water.

Prior to joining American Water, Ms. Hardwick served as Executive Vice President and CFO of Vectren Corporation. In this role, Ms. Hardwick was a member of the executive leadership team responsible for development and execution of business and financial strategy for both the regulated utility businesses, as well as the market-based subsidiaries.

Ms. Hardwick was elected to the Board of Directors of New Jersey Resources, Inc. in September 2020. She currently serves on the National Board of Directors and as Treasurer of Family Promise, Inc, sits on the Board of the Philadelphia Chamber of Commerce, and has also served in leadership positions on a variety of community boards over the course of her career. Appointed by the Governor, Ms. Hardwick served two terms as an Arts Commissioner for the state of Indiana. She was also the recipient of the Athena Award in 2009 by the Chamber of Commerce of Southwestern Indiana, the Sara B. Davies Leadership Award in 2016 presented by Leadership Evansville, and the Torchbearer Lifetime Achievement Award in 2016 presented by the Indiana Commission on Women. Also, in 2016, she was named CFO of the Year Honoree by the Indianapolis Business Journal and by the Philadelphia Business Journal in 2020. Ms. Hardwick was recognized as a 2021 Top 50 Financial Leader by the National Diversity Council and was inducted into the Evansville Regional Business Hall of Fame in December 2021.

She has also held numerous leadership and committee roles with the American Gas Association and the Edison Electric Institute, is a CPA and holds an accounting degree from Indiana University.



## Julie Sloat is President and Chief Executive Officer of American Electric Power

She most recently served as president and chief financial officer of AEP from August to December 2022. She was named executive vice president and chief financial officer effective January 2021 and was responsible for accounting and tax, treasury and risk, corporate planning and budgeting, and investor relations. Previously Sloat served as senior vice president, Treasury and Risk. She led all elements of the treasury function including the cultivation of banker, investor and rating agency relationships to support the capital market needs of the company; cash flow management and forecasting; development of capitalization strategy and monitoring of key credit metrics; and the management of AEP's trusts and investments function which includes establishing funding strategies and performance monitoring of Pension, OPEB, and other obligations. She was also responsible for the comprehensive management of the corporation's risk including operational, market, credit, insurance, enterprise risk management, and business continuity.

Prior to that, Sloat served as president and chief operating officer of AEP Ohio where she was responsible for all aspects of electric service for AEP Ohio's 1.5 million customers and leading 1,500 employees plus contract employees. She also held several key leadership positions since joining the company in 1999: senior vice president and treasurer; vice president, Regulatory Case Management; vice president, Treasurer and Investor Relations; vice president, Investor Relations, Strategic Initiatives and Economic Forecasting; as well as a role in Credit Risk Management.

In addition to her AEP career, Sloat was vice president of Corporate Finance and Investor Relations at Tween Brands, Inc., in 2008 and 2009. She was employed by Bank One (JP Morgan) from 1995 to 1999, serving as a bank debt underwriter and buy side equity analyst covering the electric utility sector. She worked for M&T Mortgage Corp, a subsidiary of M&T Bank Corp., from 1993 to 1995.

Sloat earned a bachelor of science in Business Administration with a double major in Finance and Economics from The Ohio State University. In 1999, she received a Master of Business Administration degree from Ohio State and was the recipient of the Faculty Recognition Academic Excellence Award and the Weidler Scholar Award. She also completed level one of the Chartered Financial Analyst exam series. Sloat completed the Nuclear Reactor Technology Program at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) in June 2019.

Sloat serves on the board of directors of American Electric Power (Nasdaq: AEP), Columbus Downtown Development Corporation (CDDC), Edison Electric Institute (EEI), Global Sustainable Electricity Partnership (GSEP), Ohio Business Roundtable (OBRT), Pelotonia, The Columbus Partnership, and the U.S. Business Roundtable (BRT). She is currently serving as chair of the board of directors for the James Cancer Hospital Foundation and previously served on the board of directors for Evoqua Water Technologies Corp. (NYSE: AQUA) from March 2022 through May 2023 until it was acquired by Xylem (NYSE: XYL), for Park National Corp. (NYSE: PRK) and Park National Bank from April 2015 through April 2021.

Sloat is an avid long-distance runner (multiple year Boston qualifier/finisher) and cyclist. She loves the Buckeyes.

With more than 30 years of networking experience, she is the recipient of numerous awards including E&Y's "Entrepreneur of the Year" in 2015, Barron's "World's Best CEOs" in 2018 and one of Fortune's "Top 20 Business persons" in 2019.

Boswell joined Unilever through the acquisition of Alberto Culver, where she served as president of global brands, overseeing marketing, R&D, consumer insights and packaging for numerous hair and skin care brands including TRESemmé. Earlier in her career, she served as chief operating officer of Avon North America and held senior positions at Ford Motor Company and the Estée Lauder Companies Inc.

Boswell has served on the boards of ManpowerGroup, Wolverine Worldwide, ACCO Brands, Applebee's and currently serves on the Yale University board of trustees. In recognition of her board service, she received the 2017 Directors to Watch award from Directors & Boards and the 2018 Most Influential Corporate Directors award from Women Inc. She is also a former president of the Yale University Council and a Henry Crown Fellow of the Aspen Institute.

Boswell has been recognized as a Woman to Watch by Ad Age, Marketer of the Year, 50 Most Influential People in Beauty, 25 Most Inspirational Women Leaders by Women's Wear Daily, and a Top 50 Brand Innovator and Achiever of the Year by Cosmetic Executive Women. In 2022, she was awarded the Yale Medal, the highest alumni award honoring outstanding individual service to the university.

Corie Barry is CEO of Best Buy Co. Inc., the leading provider of consumer technology products and services, with approximately 100,000 employees in North America and \$47 billion in annual revenue. She also serves on the company's board of directors.

Under Corie's leadership, Best Buy is driving toward being one of the best places to work in America, doubling our significant customer relationship events to 50 million and growing annual revenue to \$50 billion by fiscal 2025.

Prior to becoming CEO in June 2019, Corie served in several other executive positions, playing a critical role in developing and executing the company's Building the New Blue growth strategy and related transformation. Most recently, she was the company's chief financial and strategic transformation officer, overseeing strategic transformation and growth, digital and technology, global finance, investor relations, enterprise risk and compliance, integration management, and Best Buy Health.

Corie joined Best Buy in 1999 and has held a variety of financial and operational roles across the organization, both in the field and at the corporate office. She became CFO in 2016 and, prior to that, served as chief strategic growth officer. She has also served as senior vice president of domestic finance and interim president of Best Buy's services organization.

Before joining Best Buy, Corie started her career as an auditor at Deloitte & Touche.

Christine A. Leahy is chair, president and chief executive officer of CDW. Leahy is responsible for the strategic direction and performance of the company as well as leading the senior management team.

Leahy has held numerous roles at CDW, most recently serving as chief revenue officer, where she was responsible for all customer-facing units of the company including its corporate, public, small business, international and integrated technology solutions organizations. Prior to that role, Leahy was senior vice president, international, where she led the development of the company's international strategy, including the acquisition of Kelway, now CDW UK, and was responsible for the performance of its international business. Leahy also was our chief legal officer/general counsel and corporate secretary. Prior to joining CDW in 2002 as the company's first general counsel, Leahy was a corporate partner in the Chicago office of Sidley Austin, an international business law firm.

Lori J. Ryerkerk is the Chairman, Chief Executive Officer and President of Celanese Corporation, a Fortune 500 global chemical and specialty materials company based in Dallas, Texas. Celanese is a leader in the development and production of materials used in most major industrial and consumer applications. Ryerkerk was named as CEO, as well as a member of the board of directors, in May 2019. She was appointed Chairman in April 2020.

Previously, Ryerkerk was the Executive Vice President of Global Manufacturing, the largest business in Shell Downstream Inc. She led a team of 30,000 employees and contractors at refineries and chemical sites worldwide.

Ryerkerk's expertise in the energy industry spans three-plus decades. She combines deep technical and commercial skills with a passion for the manufacturing business. Her unwavering focus on safety, environmental and social performance is the foundation on which she has overseen some of the most technically complex operations in the industry.

Ryerkerk joined Shell in May 2010 as the Regional Vice President of Manufacturing in Europe and Africa, and was responsible for the operation of five Shell Manufacturing facilities and five joint ventures. During that time, she improved operational performance of all assets in the region. In October 2013, she was named Executive Vice President of Global Manufacturing, Shell Downstream Inc.

Before joining Shell, she was Senior Vice President, Refining, Supply and Terminals at Hess Corporation, where she was responsible for two refineries, 21 terminals (and distribution network) and supply and trading.

Prior to that, Ryerkerk spent 24 years with ExxonMobil where she started her career as a process technologist at a refinery in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Throughout her tenure at ExxonMobil, she took on a variety of operational and senior leadership roles in Refining and Chemicals Manufacturing, Power Generation, and various other groups including Supply, Economics and Planning, HSSE, and Public Affairs/Government Relations. Those assignments took her across the globe, from the U.S. to Europe to Asia.

Ryerkerk is a graduate of Iowa State University, where she completed her Chemical Engineering degree. She currently serves on the board of directors of Eaton Corporation, a leading provider of power management technologies and services; and previously she served on the board of Axalta Coating Systems, a leading provider of liquid and powder coatings. Additionally, she actively supports a variety of organizations in her hometown of Beaumont, Texas.





## Sarah London is Chief Executive Officer of Centene Corporation

Sarah London is CEO of Centene Corporation, a Fortune 50 company and leading national healthcare payer that takes a unique local approach to providing fully integrated, high-quality, and cost-effective services. Centene focuses on government-sponsored healthcare programs and primarily serves underinsured and uninsured individuals.

Ms. London has spent her career at the intersection of health data, technology and healthcare delivery transformation. Before her 2022 appointment to CEO, she was Centene's Vice Chairman, responsible for strategy, technology, ancillary services, enterprise compliance and quality, as well as for Centene's portfolio of independent, non health plan companies. Prior to Centene she was an Operating Partner at Optum Ventures, the venture capital arm of UnitedHealth Group. Previously, she held roles at Optum Analytics, first serving as Vice President of Client Services and then later becoming its Chief Product Officer, where she drove the strategy and commercialization of the company's integrated data solutions for the provider, payer, and life sciences markets. She joined Optum after it acquired Humedica, a clinical analytics start-up, where she led the client services and operations team.

Ms. London's career has been driven by her early experiences working to improve health care for people of all backgrounds, holding positions at Accretive Health (now R1 RCM), which works with health systems and providers on their revenue cycle to create greater financial stability and better patient experiences, and at Health Leads, a leading national organization that systematically addresses social determinants of health through data and unique community partnership models.

Ms. London graduated magna cum laude from Harvard College where she played Division I tennis. She also holds a Master of Business Administration with High Honors from the University of Chicago Booth School of Business.



## **Leagh Turner is Co-Chief Executive Officer of Ceridian HCM Holding Inc.**

Leagh Turner is Co-CEO of Ceridian and a member of the company's Board of Directors. Leagh oversees the end-to-end operations and strong execution that are fundamental to Ceridian's growth. Leagh joined Ceridian in 2018, serving as President and Chief Operating Officer.

Since becoming CEO in March 2021, Jane has launched a multi-year strategy to increase Citi's profitability and better position the firm for the speed and complexities of the digital age. This effort includes the transformation of Citi's risk and control environment by modernizing infrastructure, striving for operational excellence and investing in Citi's culture. Jane is committed to making Citi the preeminent banking partner for institutions with cross-border needs, a global leader in wealth management and a valued personal bank in its home market of the U.S.

During her 19-year career at Citi, Jane has held leadership roles across Citi's consumer and institutional businesses. Before becoming CEO, she was President of Citi and CEO of the Global Consumer Bank, responsible for all of Citi's consumer businesses in 19 markets. She also spearheaded the firm's efforts to navigate the COVID-19 pandemic, which she carried into her position as CEO.

Jane joined Citi in 2004 in the Corporate and Investment Banking division. Jane served as Citi's Global Head of Strategy and Mergers & Acquisitions from 2007 to 2009, as the CEO of Citi's Global Private Bank from 2009 to 2013, as the CEO of Citi Mortgage from 2013 to 2014, as the CEO of the U.S. Consumer and Commercial Bank and Global Mortgages from 2014 to 2015 and as the CEO of Citigroup Latin America from 2015 to 2019.

Before joining Citi, Jane was a Partner at McKinsey & Company. She started her career at Goldman Sachs in the Mergers & Acquisitions department in London and then worked for Asesores Bursátiles in Madrid.

Jane serves on the Board of Directors of the Business Roundtable and the Council on Foreign Relations. She is Vice Chair of the Partnership for New York City as well as the Financial Services Forum and a member of the Monetary Authority of Singapore's International Advisory Panel, Harvard Business School's Board of Dean's Advisors, the Stanford Global Advisory Board, the Economic Club of New York and President Biden's Export Council. Jane has an M.B.A. from Harvard Business School and an M.A. in economics from Cambridge University. She is married with two children.



## Jennifer Rumsey is Chair and Chief Executive Officer of Cummins, Inc.

Jennifer Rumsey became Chair and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Cummins Inc., the largest independent maker of diesel engines and related products in the world, on August 1, 2023.

Rumsey was named President and CEO on August 1, 2022. Prior to her current role, Rumsey was President and Chief Operating Officer which she assumed in March 2021. Rumsey was Vice President and President of Components Segment, one of Cummins' five business segments. 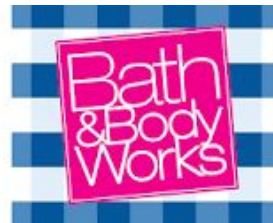

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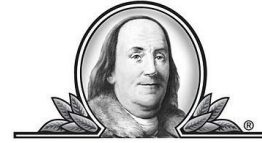


